Description: The two story, gable front frame residence with three-ranked facade and side hall entry includes a rectangular plan. The house features: clapboard, a stone and brick foundation, 2/2 double hung sash windows with flat casings, crowns and replacement shutters. The fenestration on the front elevation is slightly irregular; the four-panel front door with four-lights is enframed by a Colonial Revival surround with broken pediment and flanking fluted pilasters. The south side elevation includes a verandah with shed roof and chamfered posts and clapboarded railing. The house is surmounted by a standing seam metal roof with fascia, boxed eaves and frieze.
